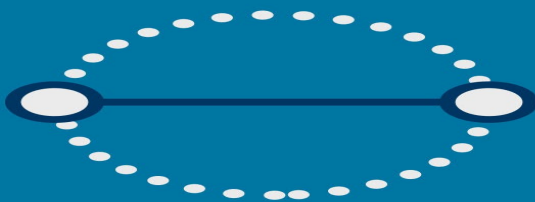

Written exams will be conducted between 9 November and 2 December 2020, so that ATAR scores can be calculated and VCE and VCAL students will receive their results before the end of 2020.

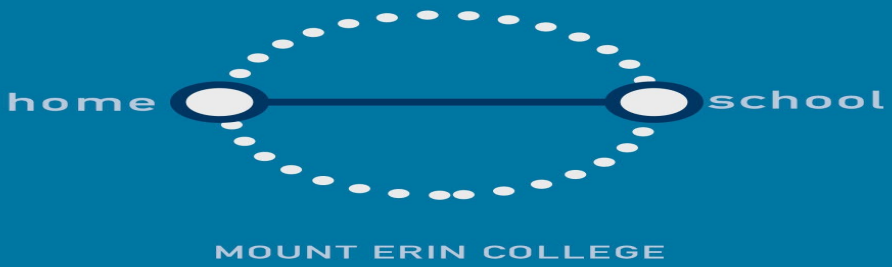
Bus service Term 2

Return to school on June 9th.

To support the health and wellbeing of all our students and staff, our school will continue an enhanced clearing routine and will encourage frequent handwashing. If your child is feeling ill or unwell, they must not attend school. They must remain home and seek medical advice.

While the Chief Health Officer has advised that students will not be required to maintain physical distancing at school, there will be a number of important changes to our school operations, consistent with health advice to all schools. Some changes that will take place will include: restrictions to access to the school site for anyone other than immediate school staff and students and the way we conduct parent-teacher meetings and interviews. Ms Lee will be sending further information to parents prior to the students returning on Tuesday 9th June.
